Dr. Vinod Scaria

Genomics & Precision Medicine Researcher; Former Senior Scientist, CSIR-Institute of Genomics and Integrative Biology (CSIR-IGIB); Chief Data Officer, Karkinos Healthcare, Kerala

Dr. Vinod Scaria is a clinician-turned-computational biologist and genomics scientist whose research focuses on genomics, rare genetic diseases, population genomics, and genomic epidemiology. He co-founded the GUARDIAN network and led key SARS-CoV-2 genomic surveillance initiatives in India during the COVID-19 pandemic. He has authored over 200 peer-reviewed publications and is a recipient of the CSIR Young Scientist Award and the Kavli Frontiers of Science Fellowship.

Dr. Moni Abraham Kuriakose

Senior Consultant & Head, Department of Head and Neck Oncology, VPS Lakeshore Hospital, Kochi; Co-founder, Medical Director & CEO, Karkinos Healthcare, Kerala

Dr. Moni Abraham Kuriakose, MD, FRCS, is an internationally renowned head and neck surgical oncologist specializing in advanced oral cancer, skull base tumours, translational head and neck oncology, early oral cancer detection, and cancer stem cell biology. He has held leadership positions at New York University, Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Narayana Health City, and the Cochin Cancer Research Centre and holds nine international patents along with several publications.

Dr. Deep Jyoti Bhuyan is a Senior Research Fellow, SDG 3 Research Cluster Lead, and Global Challenge Lead at the NICM Health Research Institute, Western Sydney University, Australia. He leads The GutBiotics Lab, with research focused on gut microbiota, postbiotics, cancer biology, and natural product-based therapeutics. An internationally recognised researcher, Dr. Bhuyan has published over 70 peer-reviewed papers and established collaborations with more than 40 institutions worldwide. He also leads global initiatives advancing UN Sustainable Development Goal 3: Good Health and Well-being.

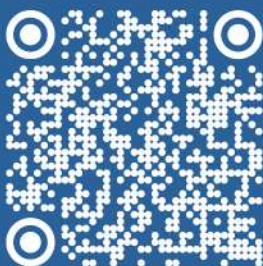
